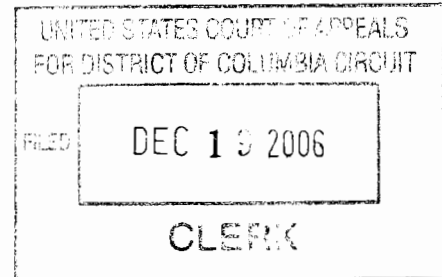

ORDER

Upon consideration of the motion of official court reporter Cathryn J. Jones, RPR for enlargement of time of 120 days for preparation of transcript and appellant's opposition and it appearing that these transcripts were ordered on September 12, 2006 it is

ORDERED that the motion be granted in part. The transcript shall be completed and filed no later than January 31, 2007. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the request for waiver of fee reduction be denied. The Guide to Judiciary Policy and Procedures states "the clerk of the court of appeals should grant exceptions to the fee reductions sparingly." See Guide to Judiciary Policy and Procedures, Section 20.12.2.d Late Delivery of Transcripts. Because the transcript will be completed well beyond 60 days from the date ordered and given the tardy request for the extension and waiver and the fact that appellant has alleged prejudice from the delay, the reporter, pursuant to the Guide, may charge only 80 percent of the prescribed fee in this case.
